

Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU)

Pursuant to the President's Address to both houses of Parliament on 4th June 2009, it was decided by PMO to set up a Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in the Prime Ministers Office to review a select number of flagship programmes/initiatives/iconic projects. The task of DMU is to ensure effective delivery of selected programmes through steady monitoring for outputs stated by the Ministry concerned, fast-tracking of implementation and ensuring trouble-shooting through periodic reviews, informing the Prime Minister on a quarterly basis on performance of the selected programmes/initiatives/projects' ensuring evaluation of impact of the selected programmes/initiatives/projects, ensuring that information on these programmes/initiatives/projects to the extent possible, is placed in the public domain by the Ministry concerned. 4.11 Outcome Budget Monitoring

Outcome Budget broadly indicates physical dimensions of the financial budgets indicating the actual physical performance and target performance. Outcome budget is a tool to track not just the intermediate physical output that are more readily measurable but also the outcomes, which are the end objectives of the State intervention.
